





St. Paul, MN TCIT (Minneapolis)	8 - 10
Kansas City, MO Kansas City	6 - 7
Memphis, TN Marion (Memphis)	7 - 8
Columbus, OH OH Valley	8 - 9
Cleveland, OH OH Valley	8 - 9

Transit times are calculated from the time of load at T18 to the time of discharge from rail at the respective IPI locations. The estimated transit times are indicative and may vary depending on rail availability and other operational factors. While we aim to adhere to schedules, unforeseen circumstances such as rail capacity limitations, weather conditions, and regulatory requirements may impact transit times.
